

## COMPOSITE FILLING

Do not chew anything until the numbness wears off from the injection. (Approximately 1 to 2 hours following the procedure.) Once your numbness has worn off, you may chew on that tooth where the filling was placed.

You may experience cold sensitivity for a few days or weeks. This is very common and should diminish. However, for minor discomfort, you may take Ibuprofen (Advil or Motrin) or non-aspirin (Tylenol). Take 2 tablets every 4 to 6 hours. It may be necessary to take medication for up to 7 days.

If after your appointment, the filling should feel unusual to bite on, please call our office for an appointment so the Doctor can adjust the filling.
