

ROOT CANAL THERAPY

Do not chew anything until the numbness wears off from the injection. (Approximately 1 to 2 hours following the procedure.)

You have just had a minor surgical procedure to remove the toxic and inflamed materials from inside your tooth. Therefore, you may experience cold sensitivity for a few days or weeks. This is very common and should diminish. However, for minor discomfort, you may take Ibuprofen (Advil or Motrin) or non-aspirin (Tylenol). Take 2 tablets every 4 to 6 hours. It may be necessary to take medication for up to 7 days.

The filling you have in your tooth is temporary. If some of the filling begins to crumble away, do not be concerned. If however, the entire filling comes out, you need to have it replaced by the Doctor as soon as possible.
